Lime green, blue, orange, blue ride on map -
80% iWay and off road pathways

One way from Bike About Tours base
45.8kms: To Craggy Range Winery
43.2kms: Bike About Tours base to Chalk & Cheese
35kms: as above - taken out Birdwood Gallery visit

35kms Drop of at Chesterhope Bridge
Note: Afternoon collection at a time and place that suits you best - other than the pathways

Flat terrain: An enjoyable country ride.

A pleasant 2.7kms ramble along Guppy Road to join the Tutaekuri Riverbank Pathway to Brookfields Bridge (4kms)

Come of the pathway up onto Brookfields Road turning left, cross the one lane bridge (Passing lane in the centre)

Turn left into Gilbertson Road passing by orchards, vineyards and farming areas, note the high river stock banks on your left. On arrival at Chesterhope Bridge - cycle along the new cycle lane (due to be completed by Oct 2016) attached to the road bridge over the Ngaruroro River (4kms) turn right, meets up with the riverbank pathway beside Pakowhai Park

A 2kms meander along the pathway to Ormond Road also known as Oak Avenue - turn left and cycle the road way - at the intersection a very large winery has been built by Delegate Wines, they do not have a cellar door. Note the farming area on your right with several shelter belts of very large Oak trees, magic ahead! the enchanting avenue of Oak trees- enjoy the ride... passing by 218 Oak trees and several very large Plain Trees. The large Oak trees were planted in 1860, the smaller trees were planted in 1900 as a driveway into the homestead owned by the Ormond family. Wine tasting at Pask Winery (3) which is just around the corner to your right (3.65kms)

Explore Hastings icons lots of iWay pathways to choose from: Frimley Park & Rose Garden, Rush Munroe Ice Cream & Gardens, Cornwall Park and Osmanthus Garden, Hastings town center a site to behold in spring and summer lots of hanging baskets. Then to Vidal's Winery & Restaurant and the *The Strawberry Patch. (8.3kms)

Detour Option: additional 3.8kms return to Havelock Road

Back track from The Strawberry Patch to St Georges Road, meander along country roads via Mt Erin and School Road to Middle Road - turn left and a little way along on your left is Birdwood Gallery & Café is a 'must see' for all visitors and locals, offering a gallery, sculpture garden, cafe and old fashioned sweet shop. (9.2km)
