Section one: Option One: Napier to Black Bridge.
Coach drop of at Black Bridge the start of your days cycling...

Section one: Option two: Riverbank and Coastal Pathway - Flat Terrain, 19.2kms

From our base join the Tutaekuri Riverbank Pathway to Awatoto, turn right and follow the Pathway beside the sea to the village of Clive then East Clive to Black Bridge.

Section two: Landscape Ride – Tuki Tuki Valley - 21.5kms

At the start of this section you have a 10 kms ride on flat terrain, the next 15kms is a combination of winding hills to gentle elevation and flat terrain. In 2011 the Tuki Tuki Road had a huge makeover, realigning and widening the road especially to keep cyclist safe.

Join the Tuki Tuki River bank pathway for (6.8kms) turn left to Moore Road (gravel road for about 1km) then right into Tuki Tuki Road which has onroad cycling lanes in various places - meander along the flat terrain, around interesting bends, then windy hills and gentle elevation as you pass by rolling country side, vineyards, orchards and farmlands. Soak up the stunning panoramic views overlooking the Tuki Tuki River, Te Mata Peak and surrounding countryside.

Right at Waimarama Road, cross Red Bridge, a little way along an avenue of young Oak trees, then to Craggy Range Winery, continue your ride to Te Mata Road (2.6kms) a combination of flat and hilly terrain.

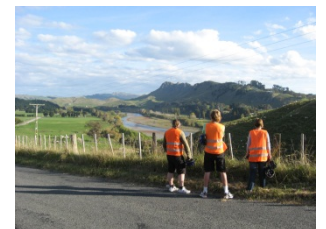
Section three Option one: Havelock North Wineries to Black Bridge 15kms

Coffee at Chalk & Cheese café then to Te Mata Estate and Black Barn Vineyards & #Bistro, back track 3kms to River Road to join the Tuki Tuki Riverbank Pathway back to Black Bridge 7.7kms - where you will be collect.

Section three Option two: If you don't want to cycle the last 7.7kms or climb the hill from Craggy Range You can be collected from a point that suits you best.

Option: You have the option of staying for *dinner (your cost) at the end of your cycling day at #Craggy Range or #Black Barn. Jenne will come and collect you after dinner.

Note: Wineries are not open every night for dinner

Option one: Coach drop of at Black Bridge the start of your days cycling...

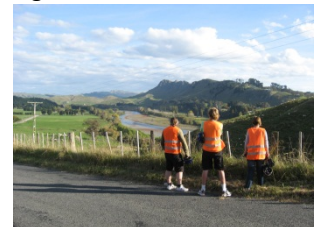
Greenmeadows you have a 2.7km ride to join the Tutaekuri Riverbank Pathway, turn left and make way to Awatoto (7kms) beside the sea turn right and follow the Pathway to Clive and East Clive then to Black Bridge, (total of 19.2kms) cycle across the bridge, pathway to Haumoana is on your left.



Cycle the pathway to Haumoana, explore Beach House Wines, Elephant Hill Estate Winery, *Clearview Winery, *Te Awanga Estate, (formally Kim Crawford Wines) spectacular coastal views. If you wish to venture through the village of Te Awanga to # Clifton Bay Café at the road end beside the sea. Back track to East Road (13kms) turn left then left again onto Parkhill Road – you have a gentle elevation to climb - right into Raymond Road – then left onto Tuki Tuki Road (10.7kms) total for this section 23.7kms

Section two: Landscape Ride - Tuki Tuki Valley - 17.6kms

At the start of this section you have a 6 kms ride on flat terrain, the next 15kms is a combination of winding hills to gentle elevation and flat terrain. In 2011 the Tuki Tuki Road had a huge makeover, realigning and widening - especially to keep cyclist safe.



Tuki Tuki Road has onroad cycling lanes in various places - meander along the flat terrain, around interesting bends, then windy hills and gentle elevation as you pass by rolling country side, vineyards, orchards and farmlands. Soak up the stunning panoramic views overlooking the Tuki Tuki River, Te Mata Peak and surrounding countryside.

Right at Waimarama Road, across Red Bridge, a little way along an avenue of young Oak trees, then to Craggy Range Winery, continue your ride to Te Mata Road (2.6kms) a combination of flat and hilly terrain – Note care must be taken as there is no pathway on this hilly section – single file please!

Section three: Havelock North Wineries to Black Bridge 15kms

Coffee at Chalk & Cheese Café then time to explore Te Mata Estate Winery, Black Barn Vineyards & Bistro, back track 3kms to River Road to join the Tuki Tuki Riverbank Pathway back to Black Bridge 7.7kms - where you will be collect.

Option: You have the option of staying for *dinner (your cost) at the end of your cycling day at #Craggy Range or #Black Barn Vineyard – check in advance for days of the week they are open for dinner!



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Note: Beach House Wines: Open late Oct to Easter, Weekends and Public Holidays 11 to 5pm –

Elephant Hill Estate Winery & Restaurant: open 7 days.

Clearview Winery & Restaurant: **Summer:** Oct to Apr - 7 days 10 to 5pm.

Winter open 5 days, 10 to 4pm closed Tues & Wed.

Te Awanga Estate: Open Dec to Mar 11 to 5pm - Wed to Sun. closed during winter.
